<b>Arrival Information</b>	<p>Getting to Duisburg from Duesseldorf International airport (DUS):          With public transportation, you can reach Duisburg within 15- 20 minutes from the Duesseldorf airport terminal (skytrain and then S-Bahn or RE train to Duisburg mainstation).</p> <p>From Duisburg Hbf (mainstation) it takes 10 minutes by bus to Campus Duisburg (Bus no. 933, 924, 926)</p>

<b>Public Transportation</b>	<p>All Summer School participants who choose to enrol for the full semester will receive a student ticket which entitles to free public transportation for the whole area of North-Rhine-Westphalia (NRW): e.g. RE, Regio and S trains to Cologne, Duesseldorf, Muenster, Bonn, Aachen, etc., as well as all Busses, metro and trams in all cities in NRW.</p> <p>For those who do not enrol, a 30-day-online-ticket can be purchased through the transport agencies. This will provide free travel in two adjoining cities for about 120 Euros, plus access to tickets for further travel at reduced rates.</p>
